1	 Welcome & Introductions SB welcomed everyone to the first meeting held at the Red Man Inn.
2	Finance Update

3 Hedge Planting - 15th November

5 Meadow Project

- Kissing Gate Awaiting delivery
- Conifers Stumps have now been removed and WFDC have put grass seed down. This may have to be redone in spring if not taken. The group agreed the area looked really good with trees gone.

Wildflower Meadow - ST distributed a seed catalogue and price list. ST
has also received an email from the Wildlife Trust that confirms from a
wildlife perspective that 'Roundup' or other similar herbicides are ok to
use from a wildlife perspective. This led to a discussion on the groups
preferred method of preparing the ground. The group concluded that if
possible they would like to see the turf removed or covered instead of
using herbicides.
