	SB welcomed everyone to the meeting.
2	Finance Update
	<ul> <li>Invoice received from WFDC for the Kissing Gate.</li> <li>ACTION: FO to raise Chq and pay invoice</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Jubilee Fund bid has been submitted to WFDC</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Vales Vets have started a fundraising project to raise money towards a new bench in the Park. They will be holding auctions, sponsored walks and selling gifts. This is being coordinated by Kerry. The group agreed this is really good and welcomed the opportunity to get involved where possible. JB will keep the group updated.</li> </ul>

3	Benches
	• Update Site meeting held on Monday with Sue, Cookie, Alan & Spike. The idea of moving one of the existing metal picnic benches to the top field was discussed. This could then be complimented with a wooden bench from BTCV (£309 + VAT). The group agreed moving the metal one was a good idea.
	The group discussed potential problems for disabled access to the meadow area. It was agreed if this became a problem then matting could be used.
	There was a discussion about using the hard standing area that will be left when the picnic bench is moved to provide a safe 'BBQ area'. The group thought it would be a good idea as last year parts of the grass were burnt from BBQs. The group were not sure if this is something that could be supported by WFDC. <b>ACTION: FO will discuss the idea with Linda Collis</b>
4	Meadow Project
	<ul> <li>Kissing Gate         Due to be installed W/C 6<sup>th</sup> Feb (weather dependant). AB informed the         group the entrance area will be slabbed. The group discussed publicity         and a small opening event once completed. IT was agreed that         representatives from WFDC, DAWF &amp; FoSG would be invited. This will         be followed up with a press release.         ACTION: JB to organise once completed     </li> </ul>
	• Wildflower Meadow Following the site meeting AB was able to inform the group that the area proposed for the meadow is 1100m2, which will require 4kg of seed.
	CO researched local seed providers and discovered 'Habitat Aid' who supply locally sourced wildflower seeds at a very reasonable rate and part of the money goes to charity. The local seed mix (Worcestershire, Herefordshire & Shropshire mix) would cost £275. All agreed this was an excellent idea and thank CO for finding it.
	The group discussed methods for preparing the site. It was agreed the easiest method was to spray with Roundup and then turn the soil with a machine. There is a potential to share the machine with other sites during that week. A provisional date for this is W/C 19 <sup>th</sup> March.
	It was agreed that whilst the work is taking place it would be important to keep the community informed.

	POST MEETING UPDATE
	Following concerns from Rob Brown, and other members of the group, there was an email discussion concerning the use of Roundup. Members of the group still felt uneasy with using this and felt strongly the group should explore alternatives. AB suggested that the area could be turned without using a herbicide however the initial appearance might not be as good. The group agreed this would be the best approach. Rob thanked WFDC for the positive response.

<b>BMX Track -</b> CO passed on some feedback from Mylo, local BMX rider, concerning the track. He has some ideas on changes that he would like AB to look at. The group also discussed holding a bike safety event that could re-launch the track if changes are made. <b>ACTION: CO to pass ideas/concerns from Mylo by email to AB</b>
Youth Hut - SB made the suggestion that seating could be provided in the hut. Ideally metal and perhaps the 'leaning' style seats. It was thought this could limit the amount of people using the hut as a toilet. ACTION: Obtain quotes for seating
